



## HIFU with FSI Sonablate<sup>®</sup> 500-System

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### PATIENT: INDICATION, SELECTION, PREPARATION

The three most important things to guarantee a successful outcome are

- Proper patient selection
- Appropriate treatment planning
- Monitoring during treatment

- **Indication:**

*T1/T2 Localized prostate cancer patients (primary and recurrent/after radical and radiation) with PSA <20. Same criteria as for brachytherapy.*

*Best results: PSA<10 and Gleason<7*

- **Patient Exclusion Criteria:**

- Prostates larger than 40gr and/or distance rectal wall - anterior pole more than 4cm  
(Unless two treatments are to be scheduled/hormones)
- Patients with large, intra-prostatic stones or calcifications (If they cause significant shadowing) •
- Patients with previous rectal wall surgery or hemorrhoids
- Patients with latex allergy reactions (probe sheath material is latex)

### **Steps to go – patient preparation:**

Detailed, comprehensive patient education is the most important tool for success and patient satisfaction
